Introduction

The Annual Plan of Provision (APOP) provides the Governors, Senior Leaders, staff members, students and parents of Ratcliffe College with a clear overview of the Catholic Life of the school and the opportunities for the 900 students aged 3-18 to engage in Collective Worship, daily.

The Annual Plan of Provision

The Whole College Plan transposes the liturgical seasons of Advent, Christmastide, Ordinary Time, Lent, Easter and Pentecost onto the three school terms. As the plan sits atop the Church's liturgical calendar, it draws inspiration from the Gospel Values each half-term. The planned celebration of the Gospel Values provide opportunities for students to meet Christ in scripture, prayer, service and the celebration of the eucharist, together with sacramental preparation, helping them to live out our School motto, 'Legis Plenitudo Charitas', Charity (Love) is the fulfilment of the Law.

The plan caters for all ages and aptitudes providing separate but familiar paths for Senior School and Preparatory School students to follow. Each school plan is linked to its own Catholic School Evaluation Document (CSED). The school half-termly plans are then split into weekly plans which include the necessary detail and resources for leaders and teaching staff to guide students in their spiritual formation.

Boarders

Ratcliffe College has a thriving boarding community of around 100 boarders. As such, the APOP makes provision for our boarders as well as day students. Our boarders celebrate the eucharist on Sundays in our beautiful Chapel, reading scripture and leading prayer and song. Through Boarders' Night Prayer, students are nourished by God's Word, through prayer and individual witness to His grace.

Evaluation and Review

The APOP is evaluated and reviewed by Governors at the beginning of the school year to ensure that it provides students with the opportunity to meet Christ through scripture, prayer, service, the celebration of the eucharist and sacramental preparation, whilst meeting the requirements of the Catholic Schools Inspectorate.

The Senior School and Prep School Chaplaincy Teams are responsible for implementing the APOP, evaluating its effectiveness and making improvements based on feedback from students, staff and parents.

The Annual Plan of Provision takes into account the following:

- Previous CSI Inspections reports and recommendations.
- Annual consultation with Governors.
- Feedback from the student body, staff body and parent body via survey questionnaire. The last set of surveys were carried out in 2023-2024.
- Regular evaluation of RS teaching, acts of Collective Worship and activities within the Catholic Life of the College.

The Annual Plan of Provision is important because it:

- 1. provides a clear and coherent path for the College to support the spiritual nourishment of the students.
- 2. provides the opportunity for all within the College community to embrace our Catholic Mission and our Rosminian traditions and work together to ensure its delivery.
- 3. is endorsed and monitored by the Governing Body and Board of Trustees.
- 4. has been adapted to reflect the CSI Inspection Framework, September 2023 which places the responsibility of the school's leadership and governance to:
- i) ensure that all students understand the Faith that gives the College its identity as a Catholic School;
- ii) ensure that all are invited to learn how to worship God in spirit and truth through the prayer and liturgy of the Word;
- iii) ensure that all live in conformity with the pattern of human goodness, truth and justice that we find in Jesus Christ.
