# About Year 3

### Beginning and End of Day



Your child can be dropped off between 8.00am and 8.25am where they will be supervised by a member of staff. They need to arrive through the KS1/Sports Hall gates. After this time, they need to sign in at Reception.

Your child can be picked up at either:

3.50-4.00pm - KS1/Sports Hall gates.

4.10pm - only if they have a Senior School sibling from the KS1/Sports Hall gates.

5.10-5.20pm - End of first prep/clubs from the KS1 gates.

5.50-6.00pm - End of school day from the KS1 gates.

# Prep/Homework

In Year 3, the children are set daily prep which should take them about 20 minutes.

Monday - Reflection

Tuesday - RE

Wednesday - Spellings (ED SHED)

Thursday - Maths

Friday - Reading/Spellings/Times Tables (TTRS)

We also ask that the children read, learn their spellings and practice their times tables daily.

- The weekly times table test takes place on a Monday ( the times table for the forthcoming week are recorded in the planner).
- The weekly spelling test takes place on a Tuesday (new words are sent home on a Wednesday).



- Two night residential during the summer term to Beaumanor Hall (information evening in the Autumn term with more details).
- Day trips for our topics and visitors/workshops.







# Uniform and equipment

Hair: neat, tidy, tied up if long hair.

Shoes: sensible, black school shoes (not trainers).

Pencil cases: all equipment for learning (especially a glue stick) and not too BIG a pencil case/ fit in the trays)!

#### Wellies/Coats/Tractor Suits/Trainers

- Every child needs a pair of wellies and a tractor suit for outdoor play.
- We love playing outdoors at Ratcliffe and it is vital that the children are properly protected.
- Coats must be brought into school every day worn to go home in and returned each day. You can never predict the British weather! Outdoor trainers need to be in school every day and kept in the classroom. Please ensure everything is named.
- The children will also need a school bag and a school sports bag.
