Pastoral Support: We pride ourselves on providing a supportive, nurturing environment, where all your child's academic and pastoral needs will be met.






## Curriculum (Autumn Term Topics)

Peripatetic Music Lesson Information - Mr Rory Finn coordinates peripatetic lessons. The school provides lessons in brass, woodwind, strings (including guitar) singing and drums.

1:1 Music Lesson fees are added to your school bill. From September group lessons will be offered.

Year 4 will also learn how to play the fife in their weekly music lessons. It is recommended that you buy your own to use. However, there are some fifes in school to use.

PE: Children enjoy one hour of PE per week, during which they enjoy a range of physical activities and skills.

Games/Fixtures: Games and fixtures take place on Thursday afternoons. School Kit is available from Player Layer and the Parent Association second hand shop. Year 4 is the first year children go to fixtures at other schools.

There is the expectation that children will have the correct kit for PE and Games.





## Uniform and Equipment

Hair: Long hair should be tied back with a discrete, school coloured hair tie.

Shoes: Black leather shoes and wellington boots for outdoor play.

Pencil cases: Pencils and basic classroom equipment is provided, however your child might like to bring a pencil case, small enough to fit in their tray to be used during prep.

Tractor suits: pupils will all need a tractor suit, a suggested one can be found in the handbook.

Water Bottles: Children should bring a small water bottle to be kept in the classroom - no Stanley cups please.

Chromebooks: All year 4 children need a chromebook which needs to be purchased through school. Further information will be sent to you.
