CO-CURRICULUM ACTIVITIES

We are currently working hard with the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme to explore ways in which we can enable our students to successfully complete the Expedition Section of the Award. We are confident this can be achieved.

The Expedition Section

This section constitutes only one part of the Award. The current situation lends itself well to students being able to fulfil the other sections of Physical, Skill and Volunteering and to keep up to date with their <u>eDofE logs</u>.

The remote activities on offer are ideal ways in which these sections can be completed effectively during this period of isolation, and this must be a priority if awards are to be achieved and awarded successfully.

If students are part way through existing sections and finds themselves unable to continue with these given current circumstances, they can be transferred to a different activity within the same section, as long as appropriate evidence is provided. School staff will be able to act as assessors and sign off any relevant sections where appropriate. Of course, where possible, and as normal, individuals outside of school may continue to be delegated as assessors for specific activities. Our students can now also volunteer for family members, for example by mentoring or coaching younger siblings.





Finally, it must be emphasised that, even though we are experiencing a difficult time, the Award 'belongs' to each student and it remains their responsibility to fulfil all the requirements laid down by the scheme. Section leaders will be in touch with students early in the summer term and throughout this period, to provide full support and advice.
