EYFS Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

Rationale

In line with the School's Mission Statement we aim to help students develop their gifts and talents: spiritual and social; intellectual and emotional; aesthetic and physical through the provision of a broad and balanced curriculum, which is responsive to, and supportive of, their needs and aspirations, fosters intellectual curiosity and academic achievement, and motivates them to grow to their full potential. Our Mission Statement is distilled into our Vision Statement, and our aim is to develop our children, pupils and students so that they have "Strength of Mind, Strength of Values, Strength of Purpose".

As part of our on-going commitment to E-Safety we would appreciate it if the parents of Nursery children could read through the following and have a conversation with their child about E-Safety. Nursery children will use ICT as part of the curriculum and have access to the internet; however, it will always be in a supervised environment. Similarly, children may have accesses to devices at home. As a consequence of this, it is important to us that children are made aware of how to use devices safely.

My learning:

- I will be using devices (computer/iPad/cameras) for my learning.
- I will always tell the teacher I am going to use a device.
- I will only use activities that a teacher has talked to me about.
- I will always ask a teacher if I am unsure about what to do or if I have done anything wrong.
- I will look after the computing equipment and always tell a teacher if something is broken or not working properly.

My online safety:

- I will always use what I have learned about online safety to ensure I stay safe.
- I will immediately tell a teacher if I see something that upsets or worries me.

Using the internet at school:

- I will only use the websites that my teacher has set up for me.
- I will tell my teacher if I am on a different website by mistake.

I understand that these rules are for when I am in School. I could make sure that I am also sensible at home, by using the same rules when using any type of computing equipment.

I understand that if I break any of the above rules the following may happen:

- I may not be able to work on any of the School computers.
- My teacher may have to speak to my parents.
