JOB TITLE: Lunchtime Supervisor

**HOURS:** 11.30am to 1.00pm, Monday to Friday

Term time only (34 weeks)

**REPORTS DIRECTLY TO:** Head of EYFS

**FUNCTIONAL RESPONSIBILITY:** Deputy Head, Preparatory School

**JOB PURPOSE:** To supervise Nursery children during their lunch time break ensuring their safety at all times.

#### **MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES**

- To supervise children whilst they eat their lunch, assisting as necessary.
- To escort Nursery children back to the Nursery.
- To supervise the children's playtime in the external play areas or indoors if inclement weather.
- To report any issues or concerns with any of the children to the Head of the Nursery.
- To work to the policies and procedures of Ratcliffe College.
- To work to all Health and Safety at Work regulations being aware of one's own safety as well as the safety of others.
- To undertake any other duties that may be necessary from time to time as may be reasonably requested.
- To attend any training as may be requested.

### **Additional Information**

Ratcliffe College is an independent Roman Catholic day and boarding school founded by the Institute of Charity (known as the Rosminians) in 1847. It is located just off the A46 at Ratcliffe on the Wreake and is situated in beautiful grounds with over 900 students in total. The School employs over 300 staff and whilst being a highly successful organisation maintains a friendly "family" culture.

The Early Years provision is housed separately from the Preparatory School and, has a Swans and Cygnet class (Pre-school, ages 3-4) and two Reception classes (age 4-5).

#### Hours of work:

The hours are 11.30am to 1.00pm, Monday to Friday; a total of 7 hours 30 minutes per week.

This is a term time only post and as such any holidays must be taken during School holidays.
